

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING -

by appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

Blessed Angela Salawa (March 12)

Born in Siepraw, near Krakow, Poland, she was the 11th child of Bartlomiej and Ewa Salawa. In 1897, she moved to Krakow where her older sister, Therese, lived. Angela immediately began to gather and instruct young women domestic workers. During World War I, she helped prisoners of war without regard to their nationality or religion. The writings of Teresa of Avila and John of the Cross were a great comfort to her. Humility should never be mistaken for lack of conviction, insight or energy. Angela brought the good news and material assistance to some of Christ's "least ones". Her self-sacrifice inspired others to do the same.
