

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - First Friday-(during exposition of the Blessed Sacrament), 8:30 am to 9:00 am; First Saturday – 9:30 am to 10:00 am By appointment only; Sundays – 11:30 am to 12:00 Noon, By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

We welcome new members and visitors to our parish. Thank you for praying with us and for helping build a Christian community.

MASS INTENTIONS: In the Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall only three (3) intentions at each Mass are allowed. So please contact the parish office to reserve your preferred dates (at least a week before). Requests will be handled on a "first come first served basis." From the PASTOR's 0779CE

This weekends' our response to the **Responsorial Psalm** is: "O that today you would listen to the voice of the Lord. Do not harden your hearts! (Psalm 95: 7c+8a) re-echoes the message of last Sunday (2nd Sunday of Lent).

Were you able to spend some time in silence? Have you stayed in a Church or some solitary place to rest and be in God's presence? You listened to His words of inspiration?

We are now on the THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT. The **Second Reading** of the Mass seeks to remind us all that, "God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us" (Romans 5:1-2.5-8).

St. Paul said in Chapter 5, verse 1: "Therefore, since we have been justified by faith" – the faith which is not just believing, but living out that belief, with love and charity expressed in concrete actions towards others, because of certainty that God is true to His covenant with Abraham to provide worldwide blessing is not yet finished (last week 1^{st} Reading).

The fulfillment of the Promise is JESUS CHRIST! We have the blessing of peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. He redeemed us, reconciled us with the Creator and the heaven is now opened and we are no longer slaves or servants, but children of God (cf. Romans 14:19).

As children of God, we longed to be with HIM. We often expressed it through our pursuit for success in all that we do. We thirst to be complete, to be fulfilled. The **GOSPEL** today has these words of JESUS: *"The water* that I will give will become springs of water gushing up to eternal life" --- the water of Baptism that confers the gift of eternal life.

"If anyone thirsts, let him come to me and drink." John 7:37
