

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

Featured Saint of the Week

St. Salvator Grionesos of Horta. Religious

Salvator was born in 1520 in Catalonia and orphaned at a very young age. After a period among the Benedictines, he chose the path of poverty among the Friars Minor of Barcelona. In Tortosa, he quickly became known for his gift of healing. The humility he sought became a point of friction among his confreres. He was denounced to the Inquisition which found nothing against him. Salvator died on March 18, 1567.

As we journey through this holy season of Lent, the Church wants us to ascend the mountain of the Lord and experience Him being transfigured before us. The season of Lent opens our eyes to a new and definitive "exodus" led by Jesus, our Lord and Messiah.

The transfiguration at Mount Tabor tells us that even the light that Moses and Elijah brought to the Israelites in the Old Testament were coming from Jesus' resurrection. Jesus is the Light to the Nations. His Light shines from age to age. This Light is radiated and given to us in the Eucharist we celebrate. Jesus is transfigured before us every time we celebrate the Eucharist.

We who receive him in the Word and in the Eucharist is also asked to let our life be transformed by the Eucharist. We are invited to be transfigured in the Image and Likeness of God by following the way of Love, the way of the Cross.
