



PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - First Friday-(during exposition of the Blessed Sacrament), 8:30 am to 9:00 am; First Saturday – 9:30 am to 10:00 am By appointment only; Sundays – 11:30 am to 12:00 Noon, By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

During the Holy Week, the Church celebrates the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ in the last days of his life on earth, beginning with his messianic entrance to Jerusalem.

2024 HOLY WEEK SCHEDULES

MARCH 24 **Palm Sunday** - Palm will be provided by the Parish; blessing at each Mass (9:30AM, 12:00NN and 7PM)

Palms are used during procession and then brought home and placed at the door or near the home altar as a witness to faith in Jesus Christ, the messianic king, and in his Paschal Victory.

The palms we receive on Palm Sunday are blessed objects or sacramentals (like rosaries and blessed medals). It ought to be treated reverently' these are not toys, mere craft material or trash.

MARCH 28 **Holy Thursday,** MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER at 7PM; Adoration followed by PABASA (*Reading of the Passion*) at 10:00 PM (*in the Church*) up to Good Friday at 12 NOON; STATIONS of the CROSS at 1:30PM

MARCH 29 - **Friday of the Passion of the Lord**, LITURGY of the WORD and HOLY COMMUNION at 3pm

MARCH 30 - **Holy Saturday**, LAUDS at 8:30 AM organized by volunteers and the Youth; EASTER VIGIL MASS at 8PM

MARCH 31 **Easter Sunday**, SALUBONG at 7AM then the Tagalog Mass followed by a simple Filipino breakfast, English MASSES at 9:30am and 7:00pm
