

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

by appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

A Message from Your Pastor

Peace and Goodness!

This Sunday, in both the first reading and the Gospel, we find Sirach and our Lord Jesus conveying the same message: The word that we utter reveals our inner thoughts.

Sírach tells us that man is tested by his word. He also uses the image of the clay that is tested in fire: if properly prepared, it will be a useful vessel but if it is not dried properly, it will break with the extreme heat.

Jesus, on the other hand, tells us that the tree is known by its own fruit. He invites us to look inside of us and examine our heart, he wants us to fill it with good things.

In purifying our heart, we purify the whole body, and in purifying the whole body, we become a temple of the Holy Spirit and a home for God. If the body is purified, the soul is purified, too; and if the whole body is purified, we can more clearly see God: "Blessed are the pure of heart for they shall see God."

As we enter the Lenten season, let us begin by purifying our hearts with the Love of God that transforms and lets us say:

"Create in me a clean heart, O God,

and put a new and right spirit within me.

Cast me not away from thy presence,

and take not thy holy Spírít from me.

Restore to me the joy of thy salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit.

(Psalm 51:10-12)
