



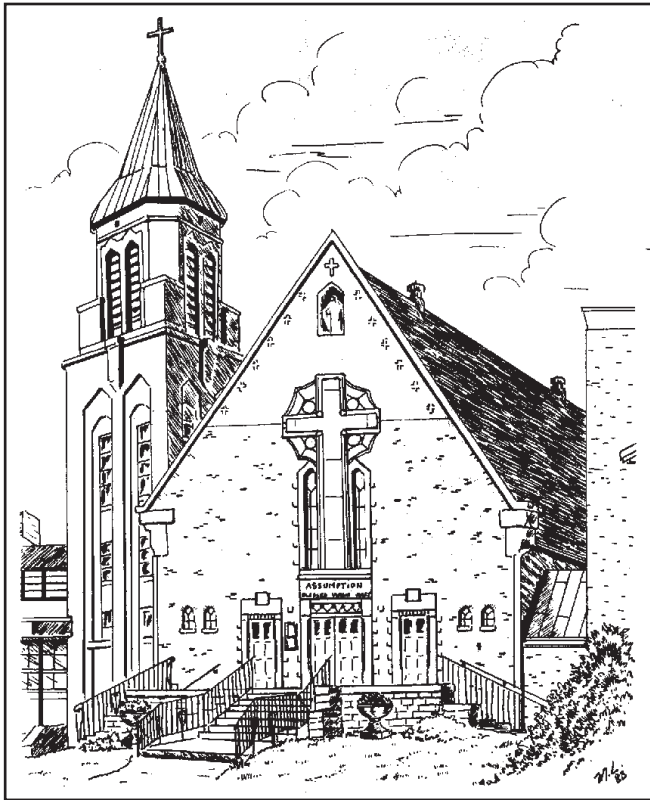

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - First Friday-(during exposition of the Blessed Sacrament), 8:30 am to 9:00 am; First Saturday – 9:30 am to 10:00 am By appointment only; Sundays – 11:30 am to 12:00 Noon, By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

is the time which precedes the great Feast of the Resurrection on Easter Sunday: it includes the last day of Lent and the beginning of Easter Triduum. During the Holy Week, the Church celebrates the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ in the last days of his life on earth, beginning with his messianic entrance to Jerusalem.

2024 HOLY WEEK SCHEDULES

- March 24 **Palm Sunday** - Palm will be provided by the Parish; blessing at each Mass (9:30AM, 12:00NN and 7PM)
- March 28 **Holy Thursday, MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER** at 7PM; **Adoration** followed by PABASA (*Reading of the Passion*) at the Church up to Good Friday at 12 noon; STATIONS of the CROSS at 2PM
- March 29 **Friday of the Passion of the Lord, LITURGY OF THE WORD** and HOLY COMMUNION at 3PM
- March 30 **Holy Saturday, LAUDS** at 8:30 AM organized by volunteers and the Youth; **EASTER VIGIL MASS** at 8PM
- March 31 **Easter Sunday, SALUBONG** at 7AM followed by a simple Filipino breakfast; **EASTER MASSES** at 9:30AM, 12:00NN and 7PM

Details of the scheduled Liturgies, devotions, and pious practices are planned by the Parish Liturgy Committee and organized by the Parish Office.
