

#### PASTORAL CARE

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

**CONFESSIONS** - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

**MARRIAGES** - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

St. Isidore, Bishop & Doctor of the Church
Born in Seville, Spain, St. Isidore (560-636) was Archbishop of
Seville for thirty-five years and presided over several important
councils, including in Seville (619) and Toledo (633). He
strengthened Catholicism in Spain and was admired for his
preaching, writings and charity. His most extensive work,
Etymologies, was an encyclopedia that would be used
throughout the Middle Ages.



#### A Message from Your Pastor

"Rejoice Jerusalem, and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning; exult and be satisfied at her consoling breast!"

The entrance antiphon of the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent, calls us to rejoice (Laetare Sunday). We are asked to rejoice because Jesus has reconciled us to His Father. The first reading shows us the Merciful God who continuously forgives the offences of his people against Him.

In the Gospel, Jesus tells us the parable of the prodigal son, and showed us the mercy of our God who is made a Father to us in Jesus. The Father does not want slaves but free children. The symbols used in the parable highlights what the Father is giving us in Jesus through the Holy Spirit. The sacrifice of Jesus does not only restores us but also crowns us as God's children. The Ring, Robe, and Sandals are symbols of the royal dignity as God's Children but also protection from God that our feet might not be soiled by the dirt of sin.

The younger Son in humility recognizes his Sin and the Father restores him. The older brother, because of envy was blinded.

The two brothers is a symbol of the Israelites, (old and new) The older brother are the ones who rejects the restoration brought about by Jesus. The younger one was the one who, coming to their senses, allowed God's mercy to restore them to the family of God.

Lent helps us to recognize our Sins and allowing Jesus to reconcile us to the Father though the sacrament of confession and rejoicing because he is merciful.
