

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - by appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

A Message from Your Pastor

Peace and Goodness!

Soon after the fall of our first parents, Adam and Eve, God promised the coming of the Messiah who will be born of a woman. His coming was announced again and again through the personages He sends to guide his people. God did not abandon his people even in their stubbornness of heart.

In the first reading today, we see Abraham who was called by God to be the "Father of a great nation."

In the Gospel, we see Jesus transfigured, showing us that the Glory of the Christ is in the Cross, the greatest expression of His love for us.

Jesus is presented as the new Moses. Like Moses, he took three companions up a mountain and was overshadowed by the cloud of God's presence. He spoke with God and his face and clothing became radiant.

Jesus' transfiguration today, revealed him as one through whom God fulfills His divine plan of old.

The transfiguration revealed Jesus not only as the fulfillment of the "Prophets and the Law", but also the "Beloved Son of the Father."

The whole Old Testament finds its true meaning only in Jesus. We too, find the true meaning of our lives only in Jesus. His continues to be with us in the sacraments he left us. Let us continuously seek for the meaning of our lives in the living presence of Jesus in the Sacraments.
