



PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - First Friday-(during exposition of the Blessed Sacrament), 8:30 am to 9:00 am; First Saturday – 9:30 am to 10:00 am By appointment only; Sundays – 11:30 am to 12:00 Noon, By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

THE HOLY SPIRIT in ART

Is often depicted as a dove. This is possibly because in the New Testament we first meet the Holy Spirit at the baptism of Jesus. Some of the passages that depict the Holy Spirit as a dove include the following:

Matthew 3:16 "and he saw the Spirit of God



descending like a dove [and] coming upon him;" Mark 1:10 "and the Spirit, like a dove, descending upon him;" Luke 3:22 "and the holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove."

HOLY SPIRIT in the BIBLE

THE HOLY SPIRIT HELPS US KNOW GOD'S WILL. God sends the Holy Spirit to live with us, teaching and reminding us of what Jesus taught during His ministry (cf. John 14:26). It's only within the Spirit that we can know, understand, and align themselves with God's will.

Instead of becoming more self-reliant to overcome life's challenges, we are to depend on the Holy Spirit for empowerment, supplication, and spiritual guidance. Before Jesus ascended, He said, "And now I will send the Holy Spirit, just as my Father promised. But stay here in the city until the Holy Spirit comes and fills you with power from heaven" (Luke 24:49).

THE HOLY SPIRIT IS THERE TO HELP THOSE WHO ARE WEAK. "And the Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness. For example, we don't know what God wants us to pray for. But the Holy Spirit prays for us with groanings that cannot be expressed in words" (Romans 8:26).

THE HOLY SPIRIT SANCTIFIES HIS PEOPLE, MAKING THEM MORE CHRIST-LIKE. Only when there is full dependence on the Spirit is there life transformation. "You were made right with God by calling on the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God" (1 Corinthians 6:11b).

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful. And kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And you will renew the face of the earth.
