

#### PASTORAL CARE

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

**CONFESSIONS** - By appointment only.

**MARRIAGES** - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

**SPIRITUAL COUNSELING** - By appointment.

## SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

#### Featured Saint of the Week

St. Joseph the Worker, (May 1)

To foster deep devotion to St. Joseph and to highlight the dignity of human labor, Pope Pius XII instituted this feast in 1955. St. Joseph is an exemplar of human work findings its dignity and value in participation with God's creative power. Pope Pius XII emphasized this when he said: "The spirit flows to you and to all men from the heart of the God-man, Savior of the world, but certainly, no worker was ever more completely and profoundly penetrated by it than the foster father of Jesus, who lived with Him in closest intimacy and community of family life and work."

#### A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Peace from the Risen Lord!

In the Gospel for the 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter, Jesus tells us that He is the source of Life and the fount of Wisdom, the Vine where everything flows to the branches. The Vine that nourishes the branches to flower and bear fruits.

How do we connect with the Jesus, the True Vine? Jesus after His resurrection clearly established the Church to continue his presence on the Earth. He is present to us through the Church in the Sacraments most especially in the Sacrament of the Eucharist (Holy Sacrifice of the Mass).

The Church tells us that the Eucharist is the "fons et culmen" (source and summit) of our life. Our life flows from the Eucharist as the source and it finds meaning back to the Eucharist. We as branches of the vine can only be sustained if we are connected with the vine, otherwise we are dead. Apart from Jesus, there is no life. As we begin the month of May dedicated to Mary, our Mother, who is called also the "Mother of Life" let us listen to her: "Do whatever my Son tells you to do" that is Trust in Him. Let us also remember and learn from St. Joseph, the worker, who learns the meaning and dignity of human work in God.
