

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

A MESSAGE FROM FR. JOBE

Peace and every good!

As we continue to rejoice this Easter season, we also approach the time of the Lord's ascension. Before He leaves us, Jesus gives us in this Sunday's readings some very simple instructions for good living. Certainly, to follow Him to the Heavenly Jerusalem, where the temple is the Lord God and the Lamb (2nd reading), we should not focus only on externals such as religious symbols, vestments or even circumcision (1st reading), we simply need three things: 1) to love, 2) be open to the Holy Spirit and 3) to seek peace (Gospel).

Even though we are all called to love, it is not always easy and it sometimes seems most difficult with our family and those closest to us. If Jesus died on the cross for us, then we ought to imitate that love in what we do concretely. As hard as it may seem to love and as much as we pray, we may not succeed and that is where the help of the Holy Spirit can, through our prayer, lift us up over the obstacles that stop us from loving freely and unconditionally. I suppose that is why peacemakers, like St. Francis, have topped the list of those whose lives have mirrored Christ's. Filled with God's love and, inspired by the Holy Spirit, St. Francis was never afraid or let his heart be troubled as he wished "peace and every good" to all and rebuilt the Church by way of the Franciscan Order, now almost eight centuries young.
