

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - First Friday-(during exposition of the Blessed Sacrament), 8:30 am to 9:00 am; First Saturday - 9:30 am to 10:00 am By appointment only; Sundays - 11:30 am to 12:00 Noon, By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

A guide to the Gospel Reading of the 6th Sunday Easter Season

John 15:9-17 - Last week we heard Jesus teach of the vine and the branches and how God the vine dresser prunes the branches to increase their yield and how He removes completely the branches which remain unproductive. Today we hear that teaching continued.

"As the Father loves me, so I also love you. Remain in my love."

Love is the principle of the relation between the Father to the Son; the same love has brought the Church into being.

The disciples must continue to keep themselves worthy of the protection of Christ's love. Not once saved, always saved – they must continue to live and love in Christ.

"This is my commandment: love one another as I love you. No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends."

<u>Jesus' own joyous sacrifice is the example which</u> we are all called to emulate. Not senseless death, but the giving of our very selves for others. <u>The</u> love of Christ gives us the ability to do this.

"It was not you who chose me, but I who chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit that will remain, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name he may give you."

The mission of the Apostles, and ours as well, is to follow Christ – to preach and teach. We can accomplish this mission when we seek effectiveness through prayer ("... through Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior ...").
