TRAINING FOR EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS

Is God calling you to serve Him as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (EMHC)? In accordance with the requirements of the Church, those who shall perform these functions must be *"truly suited"*. This means that the person must be at least 18 years old, must be a fully initiated Catholic living in communion with the Church and should not be living in an invalid marriage or in any other state of grave sin.

The second requirement of the Church is that EHC's *"Should receive careful preparation"* and be commissioned in this Holy Ministry. To this end, we are offering two opportunities for training in this ministry. **One session will be on Thursday November 22, 2012 from 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm. The second session will be provided on Saturday November 24th from 9:00 am to 11:00 am.** If you wish to serve the Lord in this special Ministry, simply call the office or e-mail Deacon Paul at beaudp@rogers.com

TRAINING FOR CANTORS: Is God calling you to serve Him as Cantor at the 12 noon Mass? In accordance with the requirements of the Church, those who shall perform these functions must be *"truly suited"*. This means that the person must be at least 18 years old, must be a fully initiated Catholic living in communion with the Church and should not be living in an invalid marriage or in any other state of grave sin. Furthermore the person should possess the natural ability to cantor. The second requirement of the Church is that Cantors *should receive "careful preparation"* and be "commissioned" in this Ministry. To this end, **a training session for all those who meet the requirements and would like to serve in this ministry will be provided on 2 more Saturdays in November. Nov 10, at 7:00pm to 8:30pm and**

November 24, at 5:30pm to 8:30pm. We greatly encourage all present Cantors and all those who would like to participate at Mass as a Cantor to attend one of these training sessions. To attend this training session please call the parish office or contact Susan Teodoro.
