

#### **PASTORAL CARE**

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

**CONFESSIONS** - By appointment only.

**MARRIAGES** - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

# <u>Featured Saint of the Week</u>

Blessed Salome, Virgin (November 18)

Salome was born in Cracow in the year 1211. As a young girl she was given in marriage to Coloman, prince of Halicsz and son of the king of Hungary, with whom she lived in virginal chastity. After her husband's death she entered the monastery of the Poor Clares at Cracow in the year 1245 and excelled especially in the virtues of obedience and humility. She died in the year 1268.
