PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING -
by appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

Peace and Goodness!

Brothers and Sisters in Christ, we are almost at the end of the liturgical year and the readings bring us to the topic of Jesus' three fold coming: He came as a helpless child in Bethlehem, He comes to us in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, and will be coming at the end times to restore justice.

The urgency and the need to be prepared is marked in the first reading. The second reading gives us the way how to do it: by being imitators of Christ, painting Christ by our lives and working quietly.

In the Gospel, Jesus tries to direct their attention to the heart of the message, not on the superficiality of "when is it occurring?, what are the signs that would accompany it?". He direct us not to lose our inner peace and to stay calm and focus on cultivating love. God will take care of us and is in control of everything. Nothing should separate us from the love of the Lord. Neither hunger, persecution, calamity, war, or even death.
