

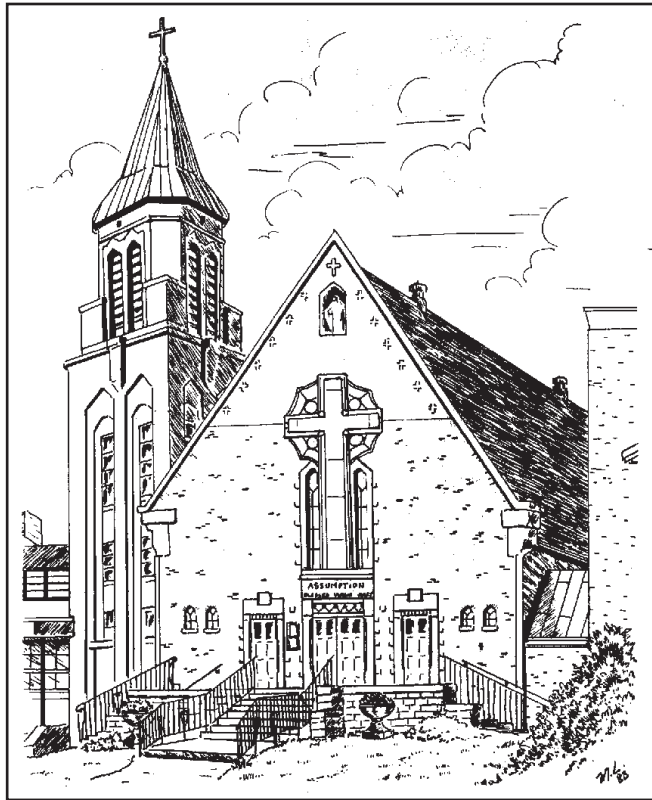

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

From the PASTOR'S OFFICE

Our parish restarted the annual observance of **Remembrance Day** this year. On November 11, I presided over the MASS, attended by numerous parishioners.

The preacher was **Rev. Lee Winchester, ofs**, who is retired from parish assignment but is still active as Chaplain for the UN Peacekeeping Veterans and is involved with Health Canada's pastoral services for veterans at the National Military Cemetery at Beechwood.

In his homily, he said, among other things: **"We remember our veterans, Those who left their homes and loved ones to put their lives on the line to fight against the wars and injustices that affected people around the world. So many gave their lives for persons they never knew or met. Some never came home while those who did return with the wounds and scars of their commitment..."** 'Every military veteran, we should realize that no matter what has gone on during the person's life they were someone who was there for others, a person who put their life on the line because they cared about people, their community, their country, the world and its creator.' The veteran made a difference in their life that allowed others to live as they saw fit without fear and danger. Isn't this what our Gospel reading was about, Is not that what Jesus is asking of us through the Beatitudes? But how many of us are ready to commit like the veterans?"

With this reminder, I ask all of you now; **ARE YOU COMMITTED to your practice of our FAITH?** Let us help each other. Also, as a community, may we be thankful for the sacrifices of our veterans and express it concretely by praying for their souls and the well-being of their family members. More importantly, by following their examples of loving service to the community and country and their dedicated pursuit of peace.
