

#### **PASTORAL CARE**

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

**CONFESSIONS** - By appointment only.

**MARRIAGES** - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

### Featured Saint of the Week.

<u>St. Leonard of Port Maurice, Priest (November 26)</u> Leonard was born in 1676. He studied in Rome and gained admission to the Order of Friars Minor. After his ordination to the priesthood he travelled through almost all of Italy devoting himself to preaching to the people with great success. He wrote many works for the use of preachers and the edification of the people. He died in Rome in the year 1751.
