PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

UPDATED INFO. ON BILL C-51: On Nov. 8, 2017, the Parliamentary Standing Committee for Justice and Human Rights voted to amend clause 14 of Bill C-51 so as to retain section 176 of the Criminal Code (which makes it an indictable offence to obstruct or cause violence to an officiating clergyman or minister, as well as to disturb religious worship or gatherings) with a new provision to encompass unequivocally all religious and spiritual services. The amended Bill will now return to the Minister of Justice for consideration, then both Houses of Parliament, followed by Royal Assent. Since the amended Bill has yet to pass into law and in view of the possibility of resistance to the proposed amendment, the Honourable Rob Nicholson, Member of Parliament for Niagara Falls, has forwarded a petition and cover letter to the CCCB seeking the support of all Canadians in asking the Government of Canada to retain Section 176 of the Criminal Code.
