<u>A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR</u>

Peace and Goodness!

This Sunday, the Church reminds us through the readings, that God continues to invite us and offer us salvation. God even sends His servants, to call us. As a mother, the Church also shows us that apart from God, our life is upon destruction. Only God can restore us and can sustain our life.

Jesus, the bridegroom of the Church calls everyone to the wedding banquet, good and bad. Everyone is given the chance to choose salvation from God. But not everyone responds to the invitation. There are people who continues with the stubbornness of their hearts.

The first reading presents to us the "mountain of the Lord", which is the Altar of Sacrifice where all good things flow. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is the source and summit of our life, all graces flow from that sublime sacrifice offered by Jesus, himself. Isaiah invites us to rejoice: "Lo, this is our God; we have waited for Him, so that He might save us. This is the Lord for whom we have waited; let us be glad and rejoice in His salvation. For the hand of the Lord will rest on this mountain."

The Psalmist even assures us of this bliss with his own experience. He finds his security on the Lord's dwelling place. He relies only in the Lord: "I shall dwell in the house of the Lord my whole life long. He knows that God always journeys with us, he is always present in his Tent, the Church.
