

# PASTORAL CARE

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

#### **CONFESSIONS** - By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

#### SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

#### **SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -**

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

# From the PASTOR'S office

Recently, I had the opportunity to spend some time away from the parish to visit **Niagara Falls**! The Falls are impressive; there is so much water flowing over them. I wonder where is its water source(s) and where the water leads. It is so beautiful; the place reminded me of God and his creative power. Filled with awe I gave praise to the Almighty, blessed the water, and prayed that wherever it flows, it may restore life and nourish everything along its paths --- up to each household, that it may bring healing to those who are ill and refreshments to those who are in need.

Reflecting about this experience, the words of St. Bonaventure of Bagnoregio comes to mind: *"the whole creation speaks loudly of God, of the good and beautiful God; of his love."* <u>How</u> <u>about you</u>? When was the last time you thanked God for His wonderful creation? <u>Are you aware</u> <u>that we are stewards of creation</u> --- that God has entrusted to our care the world he has created?

To be faithful to this steward's task, we ought to spend time (as individuals and as a parish community) to reflect our lifestyle, decisions, and our choices related to our responsibility toward promoting the INTEGRITY of CREATION. Therefore, the parish will celebrate the Season of Creation by having "Care for Creation Masses" this coming October 1 and 2, 2022. In addition, groups and mandated organizations are also to discuss (within October) their particular way of being stewards of God's creation and adopt a specific manner of its realization.
