

#### PASTORAL CARE

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

**CONFESSIONS** - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

**MARRIAGES** - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

#### A Message from Your Pastor

Peace and Goodness!

The readings for this Sunday, underlines the importance of persistent prayers in the life of every Christian.

The first reading tells us the story of God who never abandons his people. In their fight against Amalek, God fought with them. We were told that: whenever Moses raise his hands up, Israel prevailed in the fight, whenever he lowered his hands, Amalek prevailed. From ancient times, the gesture of raising hands has always been the gesture of prayer of the priests. A symbol of openness but also a symbol of submission, abandoning everything to God, a gesture of letting go.

If we abandon our life to God, we let go of our burdens and difficulties and in doing so, we are letting God help us, letting Him be a "Father" to us.

Jesus, in today's Gospel encourage us to be persistent in prayer, to pray unceasingly because in doing so, we increase our Faith, Hope, and Charity. He assures us that God will respond because he is "Our Father" and He will never abandon us.
