PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

Today, the 30th Sunday of ordinary time, we continue with the theme of prayer. Today's readings help us to deepen our understanding of authentic prayer. The first reading shows us that real prayer should help us know more of God, our loving Father, and in knowing him, we definitely would know ourselves. If our relationship with God is real and true, it would be like a mirror that helps us know more about ourselves. It helps us to see our sinfulness before the purity of the Father. But it also shows us the mercy and love of God that purifies us and raise us up. Knowing and seeing these clearly, we cannot but be grateful for the generosity and love of God.

The Gospel for this Sunday shows it clearly. The contrast between the prayer of the Pharisee and the tax collector indicate who has the authentic relationship with God. The Pharisee's prayer makes him despise his neighbor while that of the tax collector will make him more compassionate towards his neighbor.

Let us examine our prayers dear brothers and sisters and try to see if we become more compassionate, loving and forgiving towards our neighbor. If it does then let us continue but if not, let us set a right prayer to be able to experience the real God.
