

(EMHC) In accordance with the requirements of the Church, those who shall perform these functions must be "truly suited". This means that the person must be at least 18 years old, must be a fully initiated Catholic living in communion with the Church and should not be living in an invalid marriage or in any other state of grave sin.

The second requirement of the Church is that EHMC's "Should receive careful preparation" and be commissioned in this Holy Ministry. To this end, we are offering two opportunties for training in this ministry. One session will be on Thursday November 22, 2012 from 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm. The second session will be provided on Saturday November 24th from 9:00 am to 11:00 am. TRAINING FOR CANTORS: Is God calling you to serve Him as Cantor at Mass? In accordance with the requirements of the Church, those who shall perform these functions must be "truly suited". This means that the person must be at least 18 years old. must be a fully initiated Catholic living in communion with the Church and should not be living in an invalid marriage or in any other state of grave sin. Furthermore the person should possess the natural ability to cantor. The second requirement of the Church is that Cantors should receive "careful preparation" and be "commissioned" in this Ministry. To this end, a training session for all those who meet the requirements and would like to serve in this ministry will be provided on Saturday November 3, 2012 and November 11, 2012 from 5:30pm to 8:30pm in the Church. Only those that are trained and commissioned will be allowed to Cantor at any Mass at Assumption of the B.V.P. To attend this training session please call the parish office or contact Susan Teodoro.
