

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

Today, we stand at a crucial time in the life of the Church, and the history of Canada, as the necessity of healing through love has reached a critical moment. While the Church and Indigenous peoples have been on a journey towards mutuality and healing for several years, the recent visit of the Pope suggests a certain urgency for reconciliation, for healing and for justice. The Archdiocese's Fundraising Campaign in Support of Reconciliation: "A Christ-Centred, Co-Journey Towards Healing" is a concrete step forward. From the PASTOR'S OFFICE

November 1 (8 o'clock in the morning) and **November 2, 2022** (7 o'clock in the evening) will be the Solemn celebration of All the Saints and the Faithful Departed in our parish. All Masses in November will be offered for the eternal rest of the souls entrusted to our prayers.

Doing so is a long-standing Catholic expression of Faith and love: "From the beginning, the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God." (CCC 1032). Also, we have the word of St. Ambrose: "We have loved them during life; let us not abandon them in death until we have conducted them by our prayers into the house of the Lord."

Here and now, we put into practice the tenet of our Catholic Faith --- our belief in communion expressed of Saints MASS. Leo XII taught us: "The grace of mutual love among the living, strengthened and increased by the Sacrament of the Eucharist, flows, especially within the Sacrifice [of the Mass]' to all who belong to the communion of saints which is the mutual sharing of help, atonement, prayers, and benefits among the faithful, those already in heaven, those consigned to the purifying fire, and those still making their pilgrim way here on earth. These all form one city, whose head is Christ, and whose vital principle is love."

In the same vein and of particular significance for the people of Canada is the celebration of **Remembrance Day**. Hence, our parish will mark this special event with a Solemn Mass on **November 11, 2022, at 8 AM**.

Come and participate in Masses on these days. Let us offer prayers for all departed members of our community and remember all those who fought and died in the line of duty to keep our freedom.
