PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

by appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

A Message from Your Pastor

Peace and Goodness through our Lord Jesus Christ!

The Responsorial Psalm this Sunday invites us to listen with our hearts. "If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts." Listening is an action of love, every person who loves, listens. It is through listening that we understand a person.

In the first reading, we see the prophet Habakkuk complaining to God because He is not listening to the cry of his people. He is not doing anything with the misery of his people. The irony is: it is Habakkuk who does not know how to listen to God. He needs to be patient and listen attentively to God speaking to Him.

Many times, in our life, the problem is we do not know how to listen, we do not know how to pray, and we do not know how to love, our faith is so little. We find in the Gospel, the disciples asking Jesus to increase their faith. They humbly recognize that they do lack faith. When we recognize also our lack of faith in Jesus, he will be there helping us grow in faith and love of God. Jesus in the Eucharist is the food that sustains us. He is the food that nourishes our faith, hope and charity. He is the source of the fullness of our life.

Let us receive Him with an open heart!
