

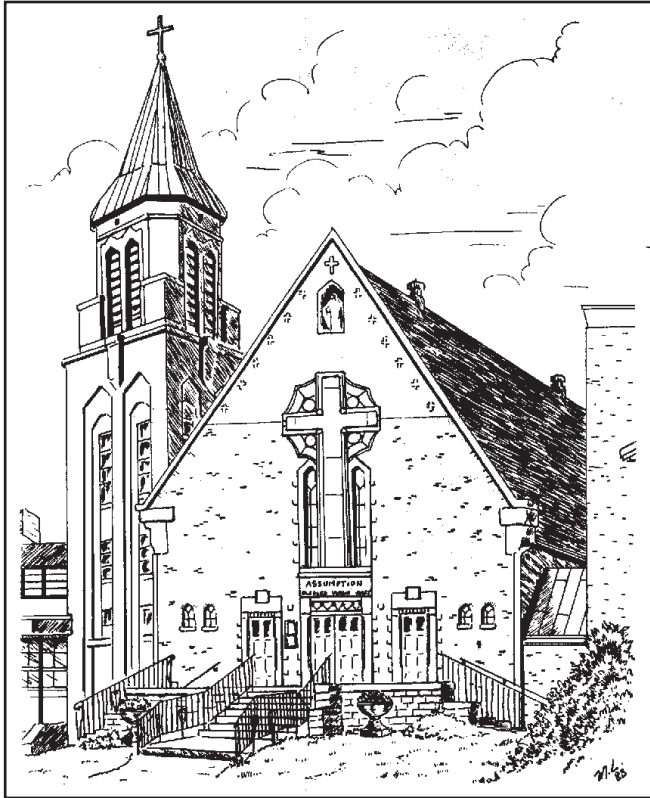

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

From the PASTOR'S office

Aside from the Archangel Michael, two other archangels named in the Bible: **Gabriel and Rafael**. These three are remembered together with a liturgical Feast every September 29.

The archangel Gabriel is mentioned in the Old Testament Gabriel appears to Daniel, the prophet, to explain his visions in **Daniel 8:15–26, 9:21–27**. While there are two references in the New Testament in the **Gospel according to Luke**: the first is in **1:13** --- *“the angel said to him, “Do not be afraid, Zechariah, for your prayer has been heard. Your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you will name him John.”* The second is in **1:28** *“he came to her and said, “Greetings, favored one! The Lord is with you.”* In popular devotion, Gabriel is that *angel of the Lord* we refer to when we pray the ANGELUS --- “the angel of the Lord declared unto Mary.”

Archangel Rafael identifies himself in the **Book of Tobit 12:15** --- *I am Raphael, one of the seven angels who stand ready and enter before the glory of the Lord.”*

Who are these seven angels? The Catholic Church does not officially recognize any names of the other four angels. However, St. Ambrose frequently quoted the Fourth Book of Esdras, which named an angel, Uriel, and archangel Jeremiel.

The Catholic Church teaches this: The existence of the spiritual, non-corporeal beings that Sacred Scripture usually calls “angels” is a truth of Faith. The witness of Scripture is as clear as the unanimity of Tradition. (*The Catechism of the Catholic Church* 328). **Read more CCC 329-330.**

Let us express of Faith and, together with the archangels and angels, give praise to God in the words of the Scriptures: ***I will thank you, O LORD, with all my heart, for you have heard the words of my mouth; in the presence of the angels, I will sing your praise; I will worship at your holy temple and give thanks to your name*** (Psalm 138).
