PRE-AUTHORIZED DEBIT (PAD)

We thank many parishioners for starting their contribution using this method. The method is flexible. You can have more than one PAD for splitting your contributions. As an example, have one PAD to donate \$X every 15th of each month to go straight to COLLECTIONS, and a second PAD \$Y on each 28th of each month to go to BOILER ROOM. In this second case, the Archdiocese will not tax the contribution. A third PAD \$Z can be deducted quarterly to donate to the RESERVE FUND, again non-taxable till 2010.
