

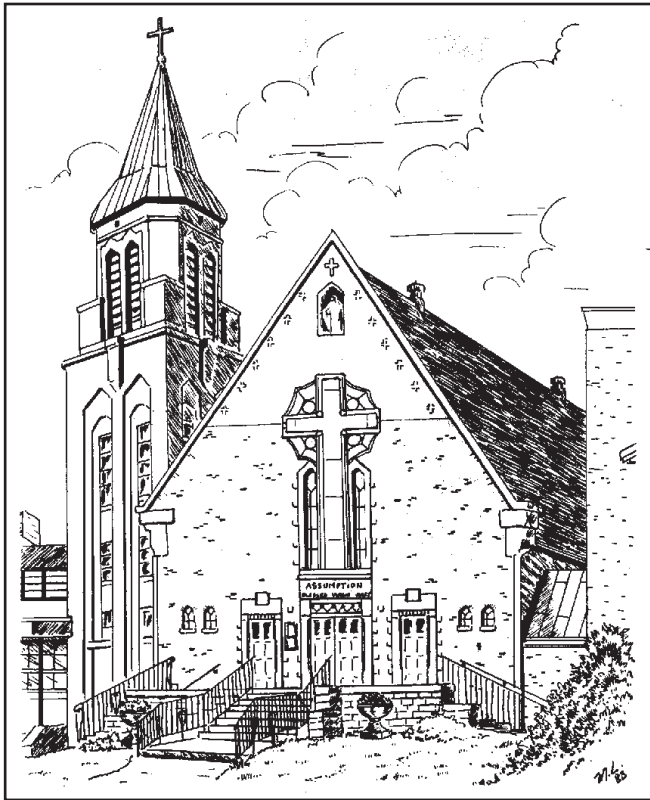

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

FLAT ROOFS PROJECTS! All the flat roofs (the parish office's foyer, the connecting alley between the Church & the rectory, the upper hall & garage) were built in the 1950's or so using tar and gravel system. It is now replaced with 2 ply modified bitumen roofing system with 2.5" Poly Iso Insulation, protection board, metal perimeter flashings and aluminum flanges. From the PASTOR'S office

Our 2022 Bazaar allowed many parish members to spend time together and share stories about their family's summer activities while having coffee or some snacks. It was fun to share one's happy and memorable experiences. One story led to another for sure. In fact, some eventually planned for their next trip together!

This year, we offered cakes (*both baked and steamed*), bread, appetizers (lumpia), a noodle dish called "pansit" (*bihon, palabok, molo*), religious articles from Italy and the Philippines, a few bottles of wine, at a lot of pre-loved items like dining wares (*plates, glasses, and cups*), decorative household item (vases and artificial flowers, painting, framed prints), women's fashion accessories, and books. Also, there are some chairs, kitchen appliances, and musical equipment. The CATHOLIC WOMEN LEAGUE has its tables, wares, and a raffle draw for a Christmas Coffee set. In addition, some parishioners rented tables and sold bags, shoes, clothing, cooking utensils, art prints, and souvenir cups. Some others did the same and then donated their earnings to the parish.

A unique feature of this bazaar is the participation of YUJUNG LANDRY, who shared her art (*pencil drawings*) on St. Therese of the Child Jesus and the Blessed Virgin Mary. *We hope to see more of her craft in the future.*

I am delighted that we finally fulfilled the intentions of those who donated those items to the parish. In doing so, we also cleared some spaces. We will use all the donations generated from the bazaar to acquire and install storage cabinets for the different parish organizations or groups.
