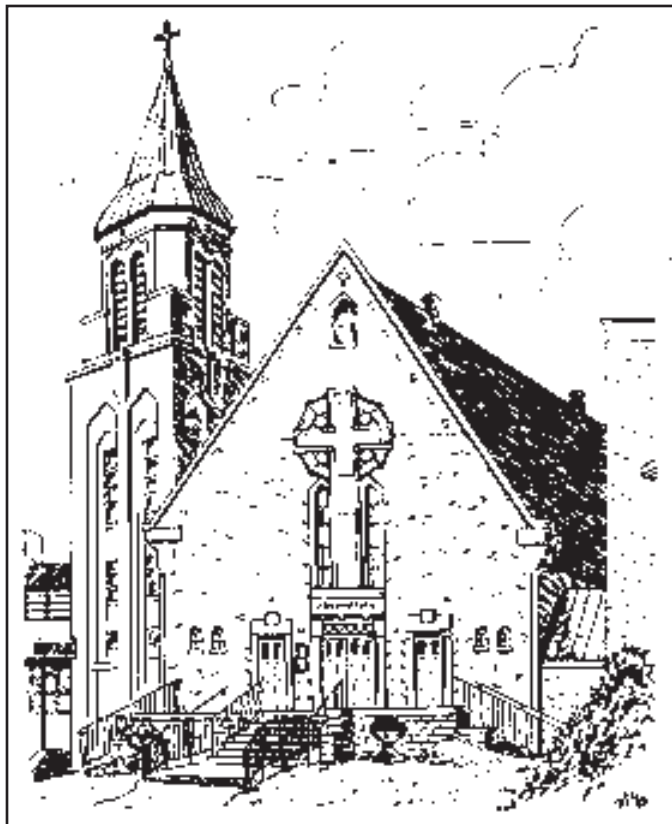

MISSION APPEAL: Rev. Edison Yohannan will be speaking at all Masses this weekend about the works and needs of his Mission Diocese in India. The Latin Archdiocese of Trivandrum has about 270,000 Catholics. 90% of them are traditional fishermen who depend on fishing for their livelihood and 10% are farm workers who are recent converts from low caste Hindus. "The harvest is plentiful but labourers are few!" Unemployment and poverty are most rampant in this community. The Archdiocese depends on outside assistance to support its clergy, seminarians, and catechists; and to continue its spiritual, educational, and economic developmental programs for the community. Many coastal villages of the Archdiocese are still struggling to recover from the recent tsunami devastation which destroyed many lives, homes, and fishing equipment. We are making progress! Yet one of our challenges is to find safe-land away from the sea to build homes for the victims. Won't you be as generous as you can in the second collection?
