#### PASTORAL CARE

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

**CONFESSIONS** - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

**MARRIAGES** - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

### SAINTS OF THE WEEK

**Sts. Michael, Gabriel & Raphael, Archangels (Sept.29)**

St. Michael ("Who is like God") is the Archangel who fought Satan. He is the protector of all people and reminds the faithful of the real existence of the Devil and demonic activity. He is invoked for protection from the snares of the Devil. St. Gabriel ("Strength of God") announced to Zechariah the birth of St. John the Baptist and to the Blessed Virgin Mary the birth of Christ. His greetings to Our Lady, "Hail, full of grace", is one of the most familiar and frequent prayers of the Church. St. Raphael (Medicine of God) is the Archangel who cared for Tobias on his journey. Every person on his or her pilgrimage through this life also has a guardian angel. This feast is popularly called "Michaelmas".

### A Message from Your Pastor

Peace and all goodness!

This Sunday's first reading foreshadows the incoming suffering and death of Jesus. We find similar words: "For if the Just One be the Son of God, He will deliver him", (Matthew 27:41-43.

Today's Gospel presents Jesus prophesying His future suffering and He is embracing His future death freely. The disciples argued among themselves and cannot understand the reason for this and the issue of succession, as to who is supposed to lead the group when Jesus is gone. They cannot understand the depth of the love of God and His humility because they are so concerned about the prestige of the leader. Jesus reminded them that it is the humble heart who can lead, it is in lowering down to those in need that one can understand how to serve, otherwise, without humility, one would only serve himself.

As we buckle up for the election of the Parish Pastoral Council, let us look at the Gospel and ask Jesus to enlighten us to vote for the future of our Parish.

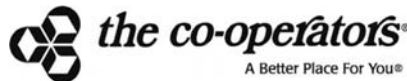
