## PASTORAL CARE

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

**CONFESSIONS** - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

**MARRIAGES** - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

**AMALGAMATION OF THE ARCHDIOCESE OF OTTAWA AND THE DIOCESE OF ALEXANDRIA-CORNWALL:**

Arch. Terrence Prendergast was appointed, Jan. 14, 2016 as the Apostolic Administrator for the Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall. On Apr. 27, 2018, the Holy Father, Pope Francis, united, in persona episcopi, the Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall with the Archdiocese of Ottawa, and appointed Arch. Prendergast as archbishop of Ottawa and bishop of Alexandria-Cornwall. On Dec. 12, 2018, the Holy Father appointed as auxiliary bishop of the diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall, the Rev. Fr. Guy Desrochers. In consultation with both Dioceses, the decision was made that the new unified diocese will be known as the Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall.

*Born in Antioch, Syria, St. John (349-407) was given the moniker Chrysostom (“golden-mouthed”) because of his eloquent and powerful preaching. He entered monastic life and was later consecrated Archbishop of Constantinople; his resolve in the midst of controversy distinguished him as much as his many writings on Catholic doctrine and Christian life. He died in exile.*
