

There is cautious optimism for a better tomorrow for all involved and a return to their towns and villages. The Catholic register has an interesting report and synthesis of the situation in the December 13th edition. *Uncertain future for Christians after Syria falls*. As we close this current year, we wonder what's next in 2025 ... in the year of Jubilee. We also keep in prayer the future of Ukraine; will there be final peace in the New Year? Let us keep these troubled situations and peoples in our good prayers.

The Jubilee Year will signify renewal for us and will help visitors and the church to reflect on "Hope in Christ," which is the theme for the 2025 Jubilee, whose motto is "Pilgrims of Hope". 
