Building a Culture of Vocations:

At a time when vocations to priesthood and religious life are at an all time low, there is a critical need for creative ways of turning this around. Where do you stand with this challenge? Have you ever encouraged your son or daughter to consider the priesthood or religious life?

We **create a culture of vocations** by taking proactive steps to boost participation in parishes and inspire vocations to the priesthood, diaconate, religious life, marriage and single life. We need to empower the laity in the life of the church and make good use of a "ministry on vocations" in addition to promoting vocations to the priesthood.

This affects the culture of faith in families by fostering an increased awareness for Baptism, Confirmation and by embracing the Sacrament of Marriage in the Church. Is your son or daughter contemplating marriage or seeking a Blessing of their present marriage (outside the church)? As I write this column, there is only one wedding booked in July, no enquiries for baptisms and very few funerals booked in the Church. There are around 20 children registered for First Communion and Confirmation respectively. Serious questions for us all!
