

Steward Uniqueness

"A good tree does not bear rotten fruit, nor does a rotten tree bear good fruit." - LUKE 6:43
Are you using your gifts in the way God intended? Have you asked God how He would like you to use them? Do you compare yourself to others and complain about what you don't have instead of being thankful for what you do have? God gives each of us unique gifts and a unique plan. Listen to how God has called you to Stewardship to use your gifts, to bear good fruit, for the glory of His name.

Why have I returned to church?

Thankfully, through God's sovereign intervention, I found faith in him again at the age of 23 by discovering a personal relationship with Jesus in an evangelical Christian church. God literally reached into my life and "saved" me — mostly from myself, and from the sinful, pagan ways I had adopted as a lifestyle by then. In this age of the new Evangelization, each one of us in the pews has a responsibility to 'reach out' and point others to Christ.
