

Stewardship Givers

"I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the other contributors to the treasury. For they all contributed out of their abundance; but she out of her poverty has put in everything she had, her whole living." (Mark 12:43-44)

Jesus gets right to the point – <u>Stewards</u> are all called to give money to support the mission of the Church, regardless of our circumstance. No gift is too small or insignificant! Giving money to support the mission of our local parish is a matter of our faith, just like praying and participating in parish ministries. REMEMBRANCE DAY NOVEMBER 11TH




Canadians pause today in silence to remember those who died in war and to pray for the victims of aggression and inhumanity throughout the world.
