Jubilee year 2025:

Pope Francis delegate, delivered directly to world leaders Pope Francis' appeal that wealthy nations use the upcoming 2025 Jubilee Year to forgive debts "as a matter of justice."

The 2025 Jubilee Year will officially open on December 24, 2024, at 7pm with a Mass presided over by Pope Francis in St. Peter's Square. The rite of the Opening of the Holy Door will follow. The Vatican and the city of Rome are expecting an estimated 35 million people to flock to the Eternal City for the 2025 Jubilee Year of Hope.

Prayer for Vocations:

On November 23rd, the Archdiocese and our Vocations Director, Bob McMorro are presenting a special workshop on developing the culture of vocations. It is entitled Hundredfold and is designed to equip Catholic laity in forming a vibrant vocation ministry that promotes vocations to the priesthood, marriage and consecrated life. Parishes have been encouraged to include a special prayer for Vocations at Mass.

In response to this special request, starting on the First Sunday of Advent and for the Advent-Christmas season, we will close the mass with a prayer for vocations – instead of the St Michael prayer.

Let us pray and support this initiative by keeping in prayer and responding to the call to action, by assisting in the development of a committee for this project in all parishes.

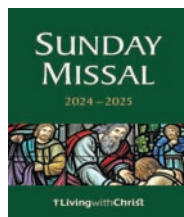
