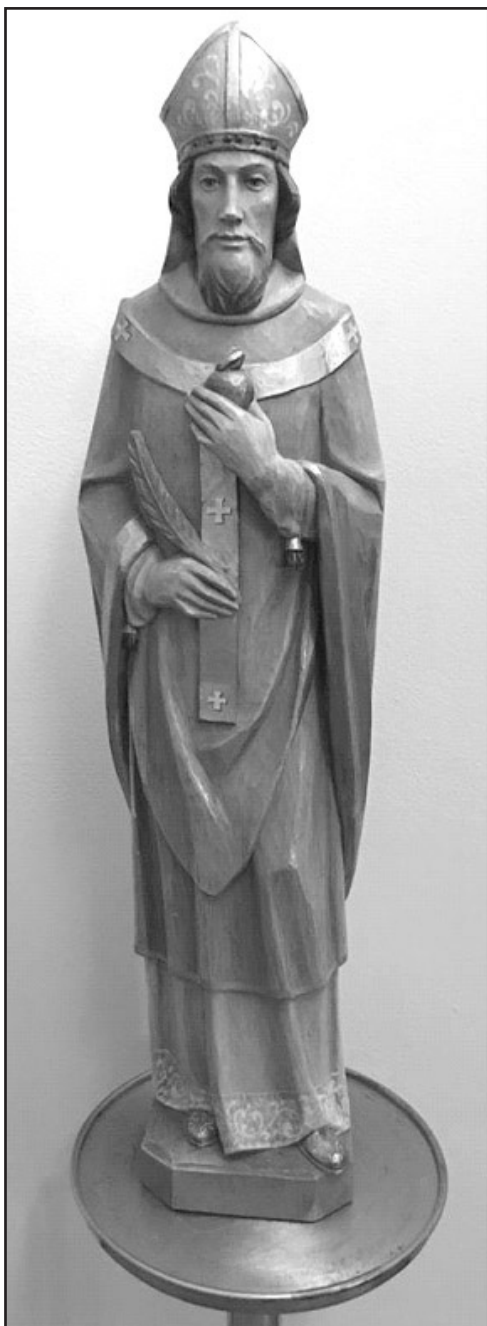

PASTOR'S DESK

NOVEMBER 3, 2024 – 31ST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**Stewardship Giving**

“And ‘to love him with all your heart, with all your understanding, with all your strength, and to love your neighbor as yourself’ is worth more than all the burnt offerings and sacrifices.” (Mark 12:33)

Of all the gifts that God gives us, the one He wants the most is our heart. He wants us to share out of our love for Him, not out of obligation. Living **Stewardship** in parish ministry and contributing money to support our parish mission is important, but it's more important to spend time in prayer with God daily and discern how He is calling us to be generous with all of our gifts. Not just the visible ones, but the invisible ones like love, mercy and forgiveness.

The new Encyclical by Pope Francis has been launched:

A world that has become "heartless" and indifferent to greed and war, and a Catholic Church in need of revitalizing its missionary joy need to open themselves up to Christ's infinite love, Pope Francis wrote.

By contemplating Jesus' Sacred Heart, the faithful can be filled with the "living water that can heal the hurt we have caused, strengthen our ability to love and serve others, and inspire us to journey together toward a just, solidary and fraternal world," the pope wrote in his encyclical, "'Dilexit nos' ('He loved us'): on the Human and Divine Love of the Heart of Jesus Christ." **INDIGENOUS RECONCILIATION FUND
SPECIAL COLLECTION – NOV. 2/3**

- Canadian Bishops launched the Indigenous Reconciliation Fund in September 2021.
- The goal of the IRF is \$30 million over a 5-year period.
- The Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall's pledge is \$1.2 million over a 5-year period.
- To date \$950,000 has been raised, or 79% of the total goal.
- To date \$528,726 has been paid out to 10 recipients for 14 different projects. Six of the projects are ongoing and eight have come to fruition.

MISSIONS – DIOCESE OF MOOSONEE**

Located in northern Ontario, the diocese has 25 parishes, 13 missions and services approximately 27,000 Catholics. With this support, the Diocese of Hearst-Moosonee assists clergy with travel costs to remote areas as well as with the high costs of living in these isolated communities. A portion of these funds also supports the campaign to undertake major repairs for their main church in Moosonee, Christ the King Basilica.
