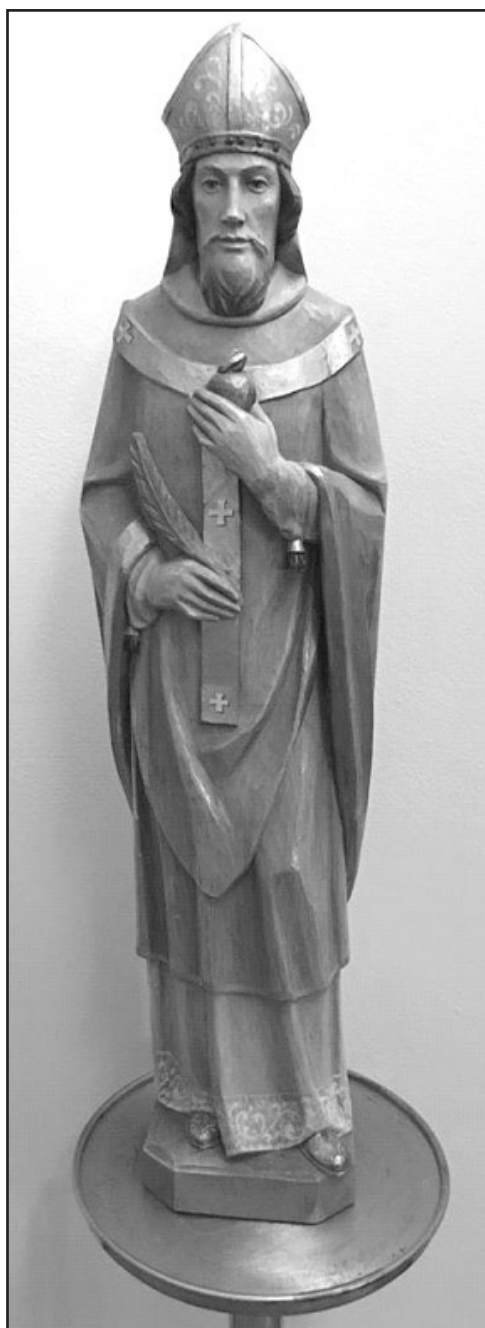

**Stewardship Calling**

*"It is easier for a camel to pass through the eye of a needle than for one who is rich to enter the kingdom of God." (Mark 10:25)*

Jesus uses tough language that we may not want to hear. However, in **Stewardship** we are all called to be generous with all of our gifts. Not just the ones we pick and choose, but all our gifts, and especially the one that means the most to us! That includes our time in prayer to God, our talent in participating in parish ministries and our treasure supporting our local parish and other charities.

**Synodal church for the future:**

The whole month of October there is a gathering of 368 delegates from all over the world, in Rome, mostly Bishops and Cardinals along with lay people and religious grappling with issues of today that will fashion the Church of tomorrow. There is a focus on the southern hemisphere where it is predicted that most Catholics will come from that part of the world; in next ten years. It has been noted how the vision of this synod we will understand years after it closes. It's much deeper than changing laws and structures, we have to change hearts, stressing the need to sow hope. It is a church that needs to listen, accompany, live the JOY of the Gospel in all seasons!

**Green Burial Rising:**

In more than a dozen states in the US, Catholic cemeteries are now offering green burial, uniting bodies with the earth in sacred ground where nature takes its course. It is interesting to note how the Jewish and Muslim tradition burial shows profound respect for the body to be buried in a shroud or plain wooden box. "While some may regard this form (green) of burial as odd, remember that Jesus was laid to rest in a shroud, without embalming or a burial vault. This has been the way Christians have honored their loved ones throughout most of the Church's 2,000 years." \*Article: Green burial, Catholic church blessing.
