PASTOR'S DESK

OCTOBER 27, 2024 - 30<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Stewardship Gratitude

“And Jesus said to him, ‘Go your way; your faith has made you well.’ And immediately he received his sight and followed him on the way.” (Mark 10:52)

Faith is believing in something even though you may not be able to physically see it. Many people think that miracles don't happen anymore. This is hard, but try to focus on the positive and not the negative things in your life. When you focus on your blessings instead of your hardships, miracles will seem common. You will see God's active presence in your daily life. You will begin to develop a Stewardship attitude of gratitude.

Update on Sacraments:

The low response to sacraments has become a pastoral concern in many parishes. As of Thursday, October 17<sup>th</sup>, we had a total 20 registrants for the Easter Sacraments - nine were registered for Confirmation. We are open to receiving requests for those children who are attending RC schools and are not baptized. Covid times have also deprived a number of children from celebrating the Easter Sacraments. In order to allow for further registration, the original information night, which was scheduled for Thurs., Oct. 17<sup>th</sup> has been postponed to Nov. 13<sup>th</sup>, at 6:30 p.m., here in parish hall.

Another Canadian Saint was declared on Sunday Oct. 20<sup>th</sup>, World Mission Sunday. The celebration of World Mission Sunday will see Pope Francis declare Canadian Blessed Marie-Léonie Paradis, founder of the Little Sisters of the Holy Family, and 13 others as new saints. - Blessed Marie-Léonie Paradis was born Virginie-Alodie Paradis in L'Acadie, Que., in 1840 and died in Sherbrook in 1912. She was beatified in Montreal, on Sept. 11, 1984, by St. John Paul II, during his visit to Canada. Note: here in Ottawa St Paul Seminary benefited from the presence and ministry of these sisters; in their creative outreach to seminarians and priests.
