Ash Wednesday: Lent

This coming Wednesday, 5 March is Ash Wednesday. A reminder that Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are two days of obligatory abstinence and fasting in Canada. Abstinence from meat for everyone, aged 14 and older; fasting for everyone aged 18 to the end of their 59th year. Lent is a period of six weeks wherein we seek a closer walk with God through prayer, penance and bodily discipline. Jesus said that when the bridegroom is away, then his followers will fast. That time is now, after the Ascension and as we await his glorious return. We will be having our Lenten confessions here at St. Anthony's on Tuesday, 1 April. Children in grade 2 and above are invited to partake of the Sacrament of Reconciliation on 1 April. Those Communion Ministers who haven't been to confession for a long time will also want to attend confession. Of course, one does not need to wait until 1 April to attend confession. Confessions are every Saturday from 3 pm to **3:45pm**. I also try and make myself available for confessions whenever I can during the week. "If we confess our sins, He (Jesus) is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9.




