Lenten Reconciliation/Confessions

Several priests from the North Deanery will be here at St. Anthony's this coming Tuesday, 1 April to hear your confessions. Don't be concerned about being an April fool just because it is April First. We are all fools when we succumb to the devil's tactics. This opportunity is especially important for the communion ministers who distribute the Body of Christ on a regular basis. Please make certain that you attend confessions, if not this coming Tuesday, then before Lent ends. Also, remember to confess all mortal sins. To purposely leave out a mortal sin invalidates the entire confession. Those in catechism and parents will also be attending confession this coming Tuesday evening.

Stewardship/Alms giving during Lent

One of the three spiritual pillars of Lent is almsgiving, that is giving to the poor. St. Francis of Assisi once said "Let us, therefore, have charity and humility and give alms because it washes the stains of our sins from our clothes. For, although people lose everything they leave behind in this world, they, nevertheless, carry with them the rewards of charity and the alms they have given for which they will receive a reward and a fitting repayment from the Lord." Let us be generous in giving during this penitential season of Lent.

Chrism Mass

The annual Chrism Mass will be held on **Tuesday, 15 April 2025** at **St. Mary's Cathedral** beginning at **10:30 am**. The Mass will be followed by a light lunch across the street at the Delta Hotel. This will be the first Chrism Mass presided by our new Archbishop Murray Chatlain. All are invited.
