FAMILY REFLECTION: "Here fishy, fishy, fishy!" This week's Gospel reading can be easily related to, but has deeper meaning on many levels. Jesus "calls" three fishermen, Simon (Peter), James and John) to leave their fishing boats and come follow him. "In the people whom Jesus chose to be his closest friends—his disciples—we see many of the characteristic foibles of ordinary human beings. We also see the ways that God uses the gifts he gave us to transform us into new people, the agents through whom God will lead others to Jesus and to his kingdom. Let's think about the person Jesus chose to be a leader among the disciples and whom he sent to "catch people."" (Sourced partially, Loyola Press). Take a minute and think about what qualities that Peter may have had. Peter was unafraid to speak his mind, but was also obedient to Jesus. He was a leader and spoke for others. He had a dynamic personality and open relationship with Jesus and was ready to learn. As family get ready to "toss" sofa cushions and make a "boat". Have the children craft "fish" shapes on paper, colour, print their names on the fish and attach some string. Get in the boat! "Who" are they going to "fish" for in their boat? Do they want to be like Jesus and be "fishers of men"? We all have gifts to share. There are many ways to be "fishermen", through hospitality, a smile, and selfless acts through the week. We too, can invite others to know and love Jesus. Pray an "Our Father" every day this week.
