Family and Youth Ministry News

Last week our Windsor Heritage Catholic Family of Parishes celebrated Thanksgiving School Mass's with each of our feeder schools. It was an amazing time of worship and connection with over 1900 staff and students. We are truly blessed to have such faith focussed educators and youth attached to the parish!

CONFIRMATION 2024: The Confirmation candidates are focussing on "What makes a good Confirmation candidate?" this weekend. There was conversation also among the adults about "What makes a good Confirmation parent?". The candidates had a great time putting together the "perfect" teen while their parents put their heads together to sketch what they thought good discipleship and parenting looked like. Our young adult volunteers Tristan and Jaime had control of the Opening Prayer Service and introducing what the "Gifts of the Spirit" are and "how" these Gifts could help us be good candidates and parents. The families then assembled the "Trunk or Treat" bags in anticipation of the event next weekend. Look for the families at the 7:30 Mass at Assumption this weekend and at the Trunk or Treat next week too. Please keep the leaders and the families in your prayers.

TRUNK OR TREAT: Get ready to decorate your "trunks" and give out "treats" at the WHCFOP TRUNK OR TREAT - SATURDAY OCTOBER 26 - 1 to 3 pm - Rear Parking Lot area at Assumption Church. This year the Confirmation Families will be on hand to hand out treats. WINDSOR FIRE AND RESCUE will be there with a unit for the kids to explore. KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS will be giving out free hot dogs and chips. FORGOTTEN HARVEST will have free vegetables. The children can run from "trunk to trunk to trunk" in a safe, family atmosphere. FAMILY REFLECTION: Everyone likes to be the "boss", yet Jesus reminds us that in order to lead one must be the servant of all. As you gather as a family, invite members to participate in a role play in which family roles are reversed. For example, you might assign children the role of parents putting their children to bed with parents acting like the children. Or you may have them role play parents asking for cooperation from children to clean up the family room. When finished, ask if it was an accurate picture of how this situation usually plays out in your household. Does everyone cooperate when asked? What happens when someone doesn't cooperate? Talk about ways in which you might apply Jesus' words in your family life. We can have authority and be leaders too. When we put others' needs before our own and look for small ways to be helpful each day and to get along with others, we are being leaders. Pray the "Our Father". (Loyola Press).


