EASTER FLOWERS



During the Easter season, when we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus, we are particularly mindful of the members of our own families. We fondly remember those who have gone before us in death. Parishioners, who wish, can make a donation for sanctuary Easter flowers in

memory of deceased loved ones. Mass for them will be celebrated on Easter Sunday, March 31st, at 11:00 am. Deadline is Monday, March 25th. Names of the deceased will be included in the bulletin insert.



HOLY THURSDAY – March 28th

Holy Thursday commemorates the Institution of the Holy Eucharist and the Sacrament of Ordination (Priesthood). The evening Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00 P.M.

on Holy Thursday begins the Triduum, which is the three-day commemoration of the heart of the Christian faith: Christ's death and Resurrection. The Triduum includes Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday and reaches its high point at the Great Easter Vigil (Saturday night). Various traditions and customs are associated with Holy Thursday, such as the washing of feet — a sign of service; procession and presentation of newly consecrated oils used in celebrating sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Anointing of the Sick, and Eucharistic Adoration. After the Holy Thursday evening Mass the Blessed Sacrament is carried through the church in procession to a place of repose where the Consecrated Hosts from Holy Thursday Mass are then used for Good Friday, as there is no Mass celebrated on this day. In the silence the altar is stripped of all cloths and adornments and the holy water fonts are emptied. ADORATION on the left side of the altar will be until 10:00 P.M.



GOOD FRIDAY - March 29th

On Good Friday, the entire Church focuses on the Cross at Calvary. The congregation comes together to contemplate the events that led to our Lord's crucifixion.

The church is stripped of its ornaments, the altar is bare, and the door of the empty tabernacle is open. There are no greetings or opening hymn. There are no sacraments celebrated on this day. Good Friday is a universal day of fasting and abstinence from meat. We come together at 11:00 A.M. and 3:00 P.M. to relive the Passion account according to John, pray for the needs of the world, venerate the cross, receive communion and depart in silence.

For many years our parish has presented a "live" Stations of the Cross. This takes the form of Tableaux depicting each of the 14 stations with short scripture readings, reflections and a hymn. It is a way of reacquainting ourselves with the incredible mystery of God's transforming love and mercy in our lives. All are invited to this moving and powerful experience on **GOOD FRIDAY at 8:30 PM.**

Today, Good Friday, there will be a Pontifical Collection for the Holy Land in support of Christian communities, the work of the Holy Land, the upkeep of the Holy Sites and the formation of future priests.

On Good Friday, the Novena of Divine Mercy begins.



HOLY SATURDAY - March 30th

The people of God remain in recollection at the Tomb of the Lord, meditating on His suffering and death. Blessing of Easter Baskets will be in the Hearth

Room at 11:00 A.M. The Easter Vigil at 7:00 P.M. is the highlight of the whole Church year and it is a night of waiting for the Resurrection. Although celebrated Holy Saturday evening, it is the dramatic Easter Vigil liturgy that marks the beginning of Easter. The Vigil consists of four parts: The Service of the LIGHT, the Liturgy of the WORD, the Blessing of the Easter Water and the Liturgy of EUCHARIST. Your presence at the entire service fulfils the Sunday obligation.
