Bible Sunday


The 3rd Sunday of Ordinary Time marks the celebration of Bible Sunday. Bible Sunday is a special opportunity to reflect on the importance of Scripture in our lives and to receive a blessing of the Bible. Whether it's a treasured family heirloom or a new Bible, a blessing on this day is a beautiful way to celebrate God's Word.

The blessing of Bibles will take place after the closing hymn at the **5pm Mass on January 25th**, and at the **9am and 11am Masses on January 26th**. Recognition of Lectors

The Pope intended it to be a day dedicated to the celebration, reflection and dissemination of the Word.
