Lent is Coming!

Ash Wednesday is on March 5th. This day marks the beginning of the penitential season of Lent where we prepare by prayer, fasting and almsgiving to celebrate Easter in 40 days. We will have 3 masses on Ash Wednesday at 9:00 am, 12 noon and 7:00 pm. Ashes will be blessed and distributed at all the Masses.

Fasting and abstaining from meat on the prescribed days is one of the precepts of the Catholic Church. The days of abstinence in Canada are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, where all Catholics who are 14 years old and above are obliged to abstain from meat. On other Fridays throughout the year, a special act of charity or piety can substitute the abstinence that is normally required. "Meat" in this context does not include fish or seafood.

The days of fasting in Canada are also Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. All Catholics between 18 and 60 are required to fast on these days. There are no special guidelines for what "fasting" means in Canada, but for example, during a fast a person might eat one full meal, and two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Fasting is a penitential discipline intended to open our hearts to God and others, a means of purification and spiritual liberation, and a witness of the depth of our faith.

Lent is a great opportunity of grace and growth in virtue, a time that we invest in our relationship with God and focus on responding to his grace whole-heartedly. Parents and educators are reminded of their duty to introduce children gradually to the understanding and practice of penance. The actions modeled by adults will be the greatest influence in this matter. May we all have a blessed and spiritually fruitful season of Lent.

Lenten Formation for Adults: Bread of Life

Join us Thursday mornings March 6th - April 3rd to explore Christ's teachings of Eucharist as outlined in scripture. Using the *FORMED Bread of Life* series with Dr. Tim Grey we will examine Christ's teachings of Eucharist through scripture references of his time in Galilee. Group discussions and individual reflections on the sacrament will shape our Lenten journey and help prepare us to celebrate the Passion, Death & Resurrection of our Lord this Easter. Sessions start at 9:45 am to 11:00 am. No registration is required to participate. Refreshments and all materials will be provided at no cost. Participate in one or all sessions. 
Youth Choir


