FASTING AND ABSTINENCE



Ash Wednesday March 5, 2025

Our parish has 2 masses:

9:00 am and 7:00 pm

Ash Wednesday is one of the most popular and important holy days in the liturgical calendar. Ash Wednesday opens Lent, a season of fasting and prayer. For members of the Latin Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 to age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. The practice includes the wearing of ashes on the head. The ashes symbolize the dust from which God made us. As the priest applies the ashes to a person's forehead, he speaks the words: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return."

During Lenten season, Stations of the Cross will be offered on Friday at 6:30 followed by Mass at 7:00 pm

60th ANNIVERSARY OF CANADIAN FLAG



On February 15, 1965 at 12 noon the Canadian Flag with the maple leaf was raised for the first time on Parliament Hill. February 15 marks 60 years since the Canadian flag, adorned with the maple leaf, was first raised.

Our national flag is a symbol that unites Canadians and reflects the common values we take pride in — democracy, inclusion and equity.
