TIP TAP PAY UPDATE



Thank you for your support of the offertory at St. Anthony's parish and for using the new Tip Tap Pay program to contribute to the work of our parish using your debit or credit card. The program has gone well and is helping parishioners to contribute to the offertory without using cash or a cheque.

To ensure the system is more accurate, we are asking parishioners to re-register their payment card using the QR code at the parish. Initially, the card registration process required the **last four digits** of your credit or debit card. Now, **the system will require all 16 digits**. This will ensure transactions are matched correctly in the database, as there is the potential, as the program grows, that more than one parishioner can have the same last four digits.

The archdiocese has verified that all transactions have been entered and recorded correctly in the parish database, and currently, no duplicate of the last four digits exists.

We ask parishioners who signed up before February 7, 2025, to re-register their credit or debit card using the QR code available at the parish.

Once this happens, all transactions that have taken place will continue to be linked to your record, and a tax receipt will be provided at the end of the calendar year for your contributions (we have removed the registration data that was previously entered.) The next time you attend Mass, please take a moment to register your payment card using the QR code at your parish.
