
#### FROM YOUR ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY

#### MISSIONARY CO-OP APPEAL COMING SOON

This year, we are honoured to welcome a visiting missionary to our parish. On the weekend of September 14th—15th, we are pleased to welcome Sister Mary Cecilia of the Little Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Gulu. Sister Mary Cecilia will share insights about their essential work spreading the Gospel in other lands. Special Collection envelopes will be available on the weekend of the collection, and your kind donation to support this work can be made in the following weeks.

The Little Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Gulu (LSMIG) is an indigenous Congregation of Catholic Sisters founded in 1936 in the Archdiocese of Gulu in Northern Uganda (East Africa. Their Mission and Charism is to share God's love and kindness to all. Their mission is to witness the love of Jesus Christ to the poor and most vulnerable members of society. This mission is lived through Catholic education, health, pastoral and social services in hard-to-reach areas. Sisters serve in Uganda, Kenya, Italy, Germany and the United States.

The LSMIG Sisters are serving the people of northern Uganda, who are emerging from a nearly 30-year period of devastating civil war while concurrently dealing with an influx of refugees from South Sudan and the Democratic Republic of Congo. Among the refugees are children who arrived in Uganda unaccompanied. The girls have suffered sexual violence, which left them pregnant, and they have become child mothers at 12-15 years of age. Our Sisters are responding courageously with limited resources to the needs of these refugee child-mothers and children in the refugee camps through catholic education and catholic outreach programs. Our Sisters respond with limited resources to the needs of these refugee child-mothers and children in the refugee camps through catholic education and outreach programs. We have developed a unique Catholic Elementary Education Center with a blend of Vocational training, Daycare and Kindergarten to support the education of the child-mothers and their babies on the same campus. This has been done to break the cycle of teenage pregnancy and child motherhood and to give these girls and their babies a second chance in school through an innovative Catholic Education.


