

### FIRE INSPECTION REPORT

In late November, 2023, our Diocesan Insurers completed a Fire Safety and Prevention Report for each of the parishes in our Diocese. Our Church, Rectory and Parish Centre were inspected, and a list of deficiencies was prepared and released to us over the summer. The list of corrections involved several areas: monthly testing of fire equipment, alarms, etc., the installation of new solid core doors in the garage and office area of the rectory, automatic door closures on several doors throughout the facility, the installation of smoke alarms, the placement of fire extinguishers and the removal of some items that are blocking fire exit corridor at the front of the church (behind the sanctuary, among other things. Many of these issues have been addressed, or will be addressed within the coming weeks, with the goal of having all work completed by the end of November.

We have contracted a person who is able to do this work, including the regular testing, maintenance and logging of work done to maintain the fire alarm systems. Most automatic door closures have been installed. Closing these doors ensures that a fire will not quickly spread if one occurs in these areas.

PLEASE NOTE: When leaving a work area in which *there is an automatic door closer installed*, these doors must be closed and not left propped open. They can be open when working in those areas, but when finished, we respectfully ask all persons using these areas to ensure the doors are closed. This is required by law and the parish could face significant fines if these doors are propped open in unoccupied areas. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

#### NEW MINISTERS OF COMMUNION AND MINISTERS OF THE WORD NEEDED

Our parish community needs Ministers of Communion and Ministers of Word (Lectors) at our Lord's Day Masses.

Those seeking to exercise this liturgical ministry must be fully initiated Catholics. They should be prayerful individuals who love the Eucharist, live a moral life in keeping with the teachings of the Church, and sincerely strive to live their tholic faith. On average, these ministries are exercised one or two Sundays per month, depending on the number of people who exercise them. There is flexibility in scheduling through an online program called Ministry Scheduler Pro.

The Diocese of Hamilton requires Volunteer Screening and attendance at a workshop sponsored by the Diocese for each of these ministries. Following the completion of the Diocesan Workshop, a local parish workshop will be held for new ministers. The bishop issues mandates for these ministries within the parish.
